The Cambrian "Explosion"

- "... some organisms appear with adaptational packages intact at the Cambrian boundary where multicellular life first "flowers," with no evidence whatsoever of fossil ancestors. ... only an intelligent designer has the ability to coordinate the design requirements of multifunctional adaptational packages."

- "... the great majority of the animal phyla ... appear ... in a remarkably brief period of time ... 10 to 30 million years..., and are not connected by evolutionary intermediates. ... there is an unexpected lack of fossils bridging the evolutionary distance between the phyla to document evolutionary origins for them."
